At present, the institution Library provides multiple issues of several different periodicals which are distributed to each range in the Living Unit (12 copies).

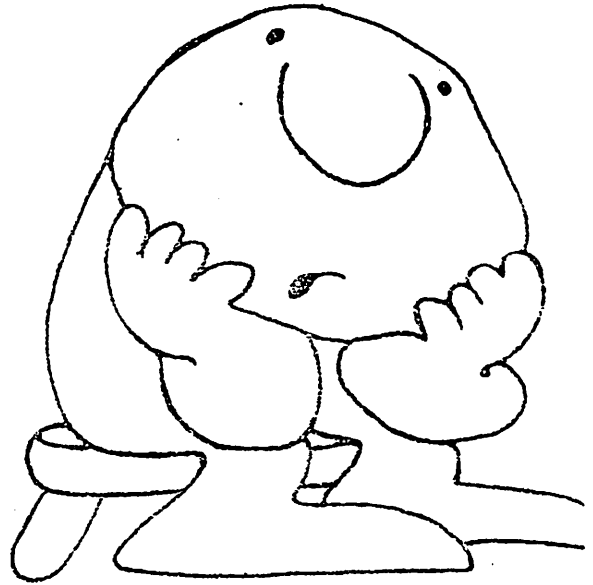
In future the Library is reducing the number of copies purchased owing to budget restraints placed on the Library program, combined with the increasing costs of periodical subscriptions. It is intended that only 6 (six) copies of the most popular periodicals will be the maximum order for the institution. This reduction will take place as the current subscriptions expire and are renewed for next year. It is intended that these multiple issue subscriptions be distributed as follows: (1 Library, 1 Hospital, 1 SCU, and 3 to Living Unit-one per floor)

Inmates are reminded that individual subscriptions to newspapers and periodicals can be obtained by making application to the Librarian using Inmate Trust Fund (I.T.F.) forms and a stamped envelope addressed to the supplier.
