ADMINISTRATION NOTICE

The Administration is deeply concerned over some of the recent incidents around Ferndale and the adverse publicity. They want the population to be aware of the fact that there are going to be some serious consequences in the near future. At the present time both Regional Headquarters and Ottawa, National Headquarters, have stepped in to express their concerns also.

The following new policy is now in effect. Starting Monday, February 27, 1989, visits will be curtailed as follows:

Weekdays from 5pm to 9pm
(1700hrs to 2100hrs)

Weekends from 12pm to 8pm
(1200hrs to 2000hrs)

Further NOTICE that the grace period on first time visitors will be strictly enforced; one visit only, until CPIC is cleared.

COUNTS after midnight will be done every HOUR on the HOUR

CURFEW will now be from 12am (midnight) to 6am. All areas will be locked during this period, that includes the pool room, weight room, V & C, and mini-mall.

Starting immediately, any suspicions of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol will mean an immediate transfer (this does not mean a hot piss test; however if you test hot, all passes and programs will be placed on hold until the urinalysis test is normal.)

SICK NOTICES will be harder to come by; if you are seriously ill you will be shipped to Matsqui Hospital for needed care; minor illness you are expected to REMAIN in your house at all times; there will be irregular and routine investigations of all complaints of illness and verification must be assured or charges will be laid.
